SDC and GI-NET are joining forces to create a more powerful voice dedicated to preventing and stopping large-scale, deliberate atrocities against civilians. GI-NET and Save Darfur Coalition have been working together on similar projects for several years. More than a year ago, management of both entities started having conversations about a planned merger to share resources and form a stronger organization At the meeting held on October 28, 2010, the Board towards the same goal. of Directors of GI-Net unanimously voted to merge with SDC, which became effective on November 1, 2010. Pursuant to the merger agreement, the identity, existence, corporate organization, purposes, powers, objects, franchises, privileges, rights, immunities, restrictions, assets, debts, liabilities and duties (collectively referred to as "corporate rights") of SDC shall continue in effect and be unimpaired by the merger, and the corporate rights of GI-NET shall be merged with and into SDC, which shall, as the surviving corporation, be fully vested at the effective date of the merger.

No consideration was transferred as part of the merger transaction. All transactions are reported as a merged entity effective November 1, 2010, under the SDC umbrella. On June 6, 2011 Save Darfur, Inc. became United to End Genocide, Inc.
